Network Overcomes the Geographical Barricades in Taiwan

- A. Taiwan is a sea-surrounded island. More than 70% of the entire territory are hills, forests, and mountainous area as shown by the satellite.
- B. The inconvenience caused by the geographical barricades, such as traffic difficulties, decreases the opportunity of education and raises unemployment, which in turn contributes to the cultural and social problems of the remote areas.
- C. Network reduce the disparity between urban and rural areas, thus, connected by the digital platform, conquering the geographical barriers.



Introduction

- The Project is promoted by the Ministry of Education to reduce the digital discrepancy between the urban and rural areas.
- To increase the chance of supplementary studies, students in the rural areas are assisted with the approach of the Internet and distance schoolwork guidance.
- Object: The combination of web schoolwork, counseling mechanism and educational resources to spur the integrity of technology, humanism and concerns for the minority.

General Project (2008-2012)

Fu Jen U. has provided leadership and support for on-line tutoring at 27 teaching sites (cooperative universities). The program has recruited tutors from these universities, combing the Internet and educational goals to cover 85 service sites.










A Glimpse of the Project
